## **ELM COTTAGE**

Take an all day drive and complete the loop from Tumut to Talbingo, Kiandra, Cabramurra stopping to have a coffee at the café whilst viewing the highest township in Australia, continue to Khancoban, Tumbarumba stopping at the Nest Café for lunch, then on to Batlow purchasing an apple or two from the many roadside stalls(in season), on to Adelong and back to Tumut.

Another full days adventure drive to Cootamundra, whilst there visit the birthplace of Australian cricketer Don Bradman, drive on to Junee to visit the Junee Licorice & Chocolate Factory, and enjoy lunch at the The Millroom licensed restaurant then on to Coolamon to visit the cheese factory offering an amazing array of cheeses. Travel to Wagga and back to Tumut.

Tumut to Yass via Wee Jasper. The section leading down into Wee Jasper is steep with some sharp bends. The route offer spectacular scenery, mountains, forestry and rural views.

Take a half day trip to Jugiong visit the Track Winding back restaurant for lunch(closed Tuesdays) then visit the "Hut" for some stunning hand made statues and garden pieces.
